From the Mayor

Dear Residents:

The West Hines Hill Road Improvement Project is now complete except for the punch-list items.

The contractor has temporarily relocated the Bike & Hike Trail for the Akron-Cleveland Road Bridge replacement, and is working on the trail's tunnel. Summit Metro Parks partnered with our Village to create a safer alternative for the Bike & Hike Trail.



The asphalt resurfacing of roads in Ashbrooke West is out for bid and reconstruction will commence later this year. Other village residential roads are scheduled to be resurfaced in the next couple of years.

Sky Zone, the indoor trampoline park on Chittenden Road, broke ground, erected walls and will open by year's end.

Arhaus Corporate Headquarters is due to start soon. Construction delays have pushed the starting date to late summer.

Design plans for the Olde Eight, Beverly, Grandview, Richard, Sholle and Wolcott Roads waterline project are near completion. Arhaus development will be moving forward on the water connection on Olde Eight Road this year. The Village will begin work on the scheduled waterline roads in 2015.

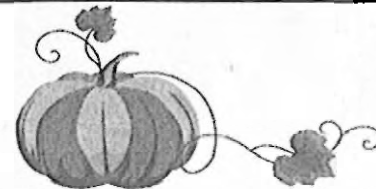
The Village has installed two new posting boards: on the west side of Village Hall and at Matthews Thomas Park entrance. News and notices will be posted there.

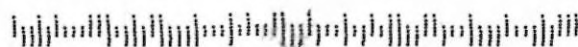
